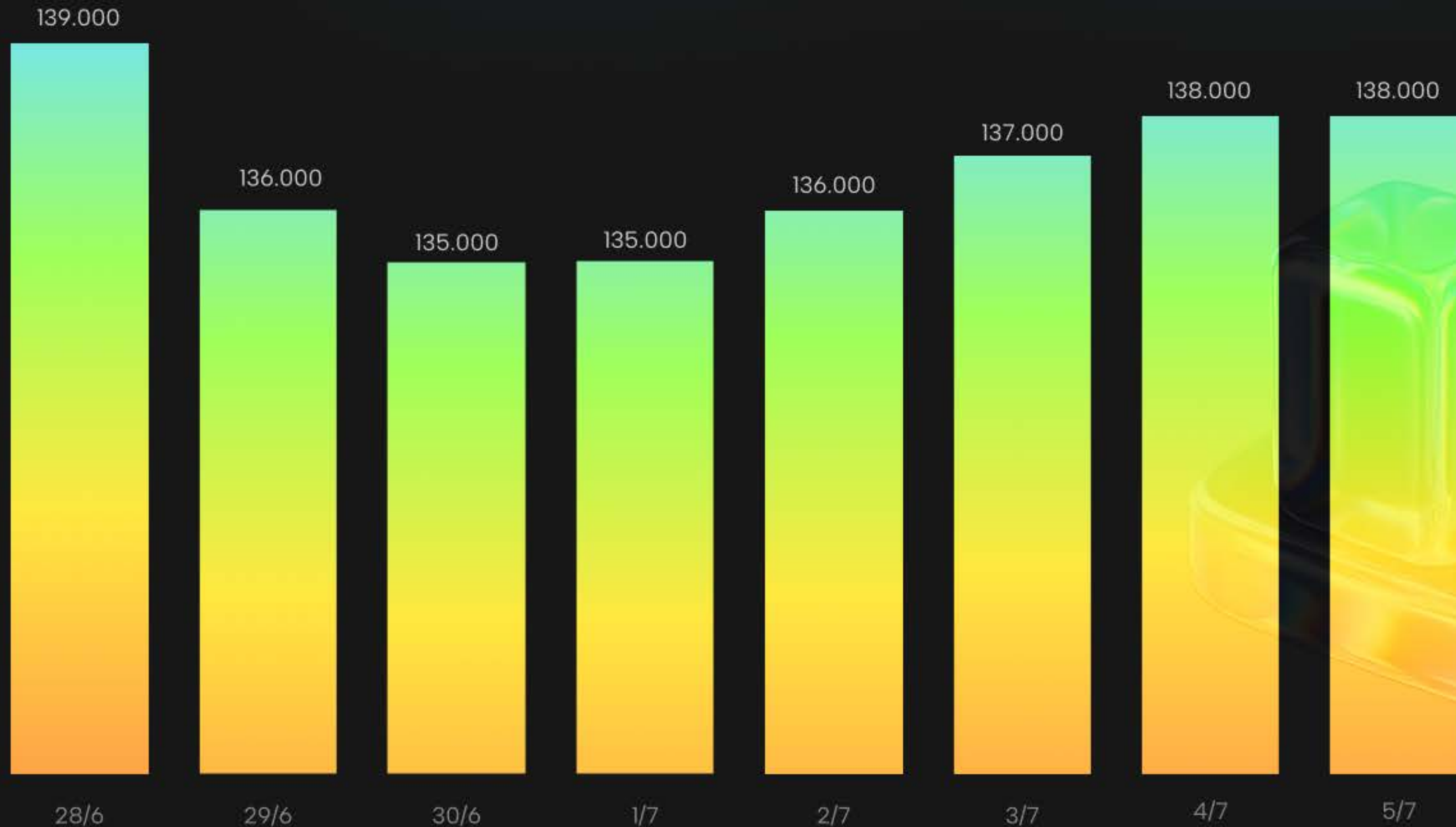

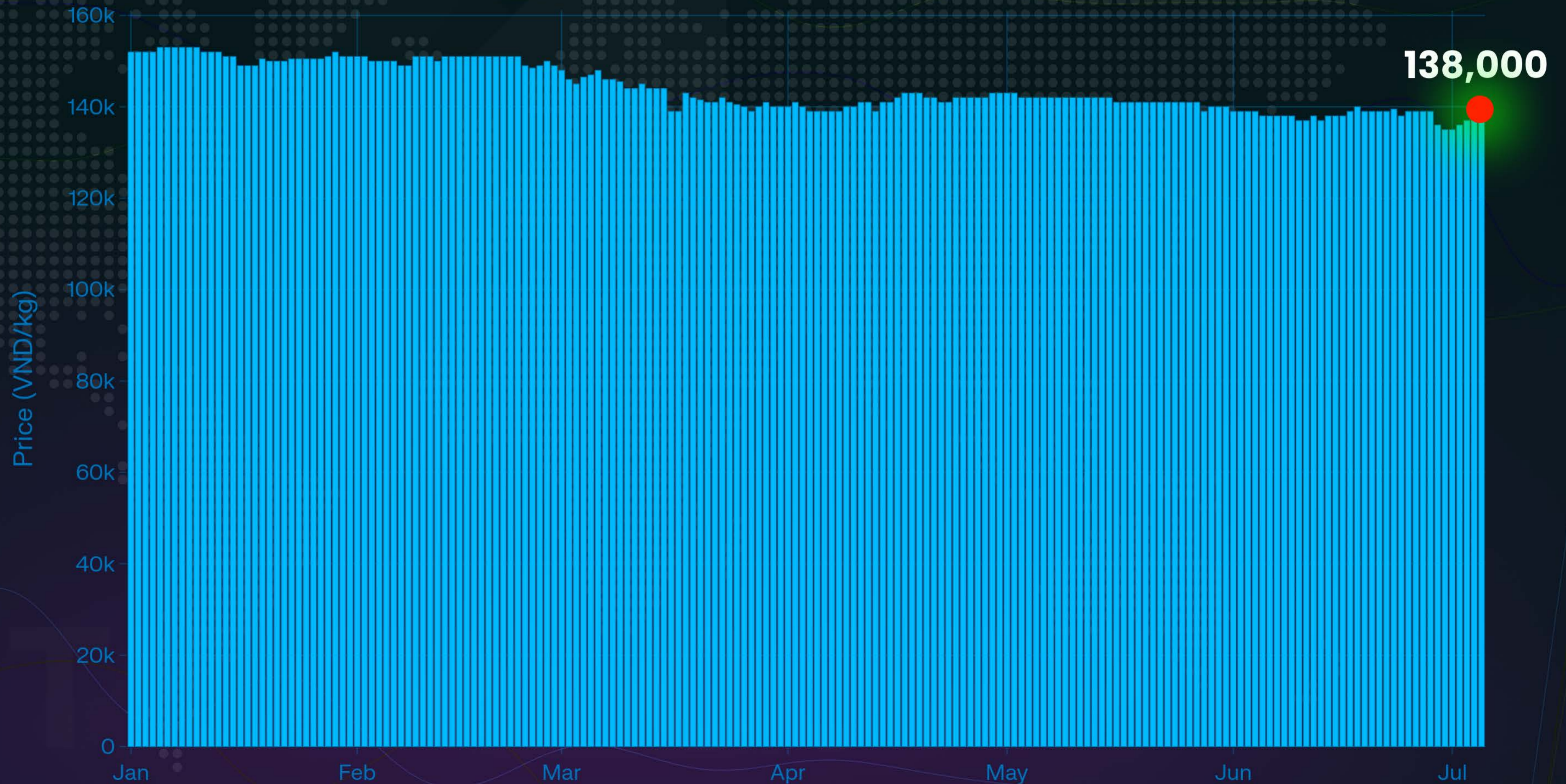

The price of pepper has decreased from 152,000 VND on January 1, 2026, to 138,000 VND on July 5th, 2026, down 9.2%.



June 2026 – Export Highlights

In June 2026, Vietnam exported 23,103 tons of black pepper, generating revenue of US\$151.3 million, a decrease of 8.2% in volume and 8.9% in value compared to May 2026, and a slight decrease of 1.4% in volume compared to June 2025. The decline was mainly due to lower exports to Asian, African, and American markets compared to the previous month, while demand from Europe remained relatively stable.

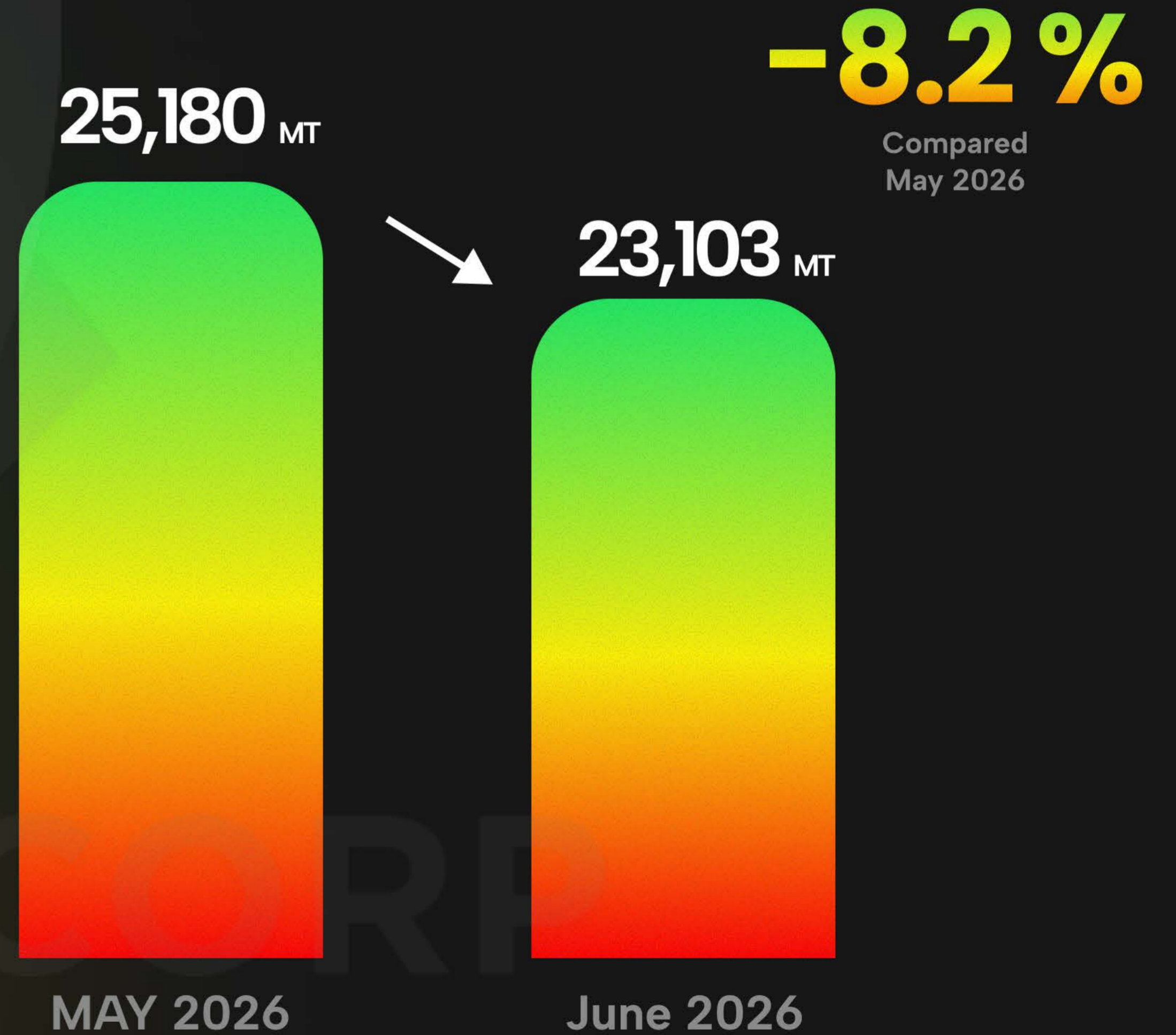

Asia continued to be the largest consumer region with 9,886 tons, accounting for 43.7% of total exports, although this was down 10.2% compared to May and 18.3% compared to the same period last year. Conversely, exports to the Americas reached 6,174 tons, down 8.2% from the previous month but still up 30.0% year-on-year, with the United States alone accounting for 5,373 tons, up 21.0% compared to June 2025. Europe reached 5,753 tons, down 4.5% from the previous month but up 16.7% year-on-year, driven by strong demand from Germany and the Netherlands. Meanwhile, exports to Africa reached 1,290 tons, down 8.9% from the previous month and down 22.4% year-on-year.

Volatile Monthly Flows

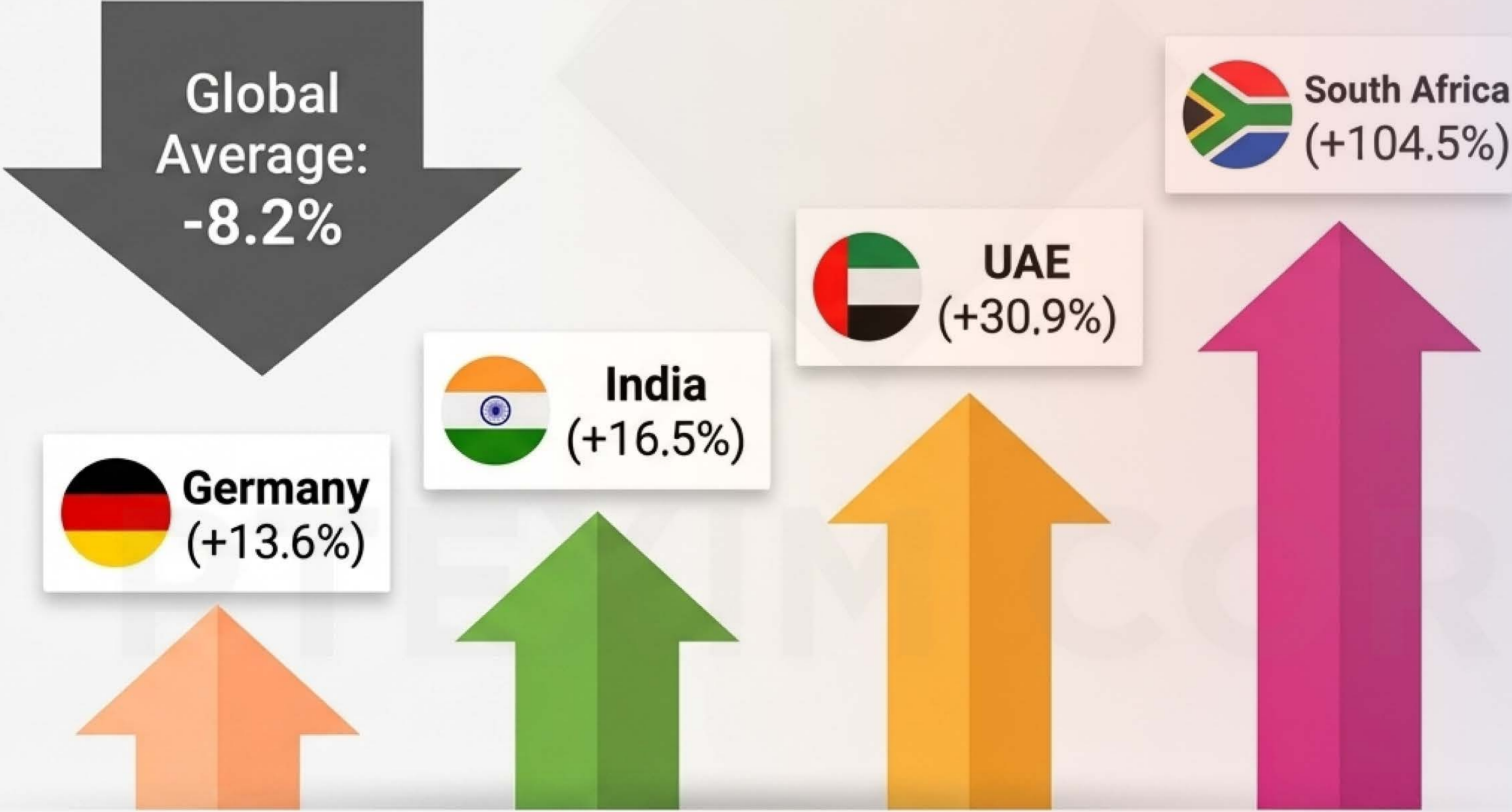
Exports in June fell by 8.2% in volume and 8.9% in value compared to May due to declining demand in Asia, Africa, and the Americas.

In the first six months of 2026, Vietnam exported 145,686 tons of pepper, including 125,258 tons of black pepper and 20,428 tons of white pepper, for a total export value of US\$940.5 million, an increase of 17.4% in volume and 10.6% in value compared to the same period in 2025.

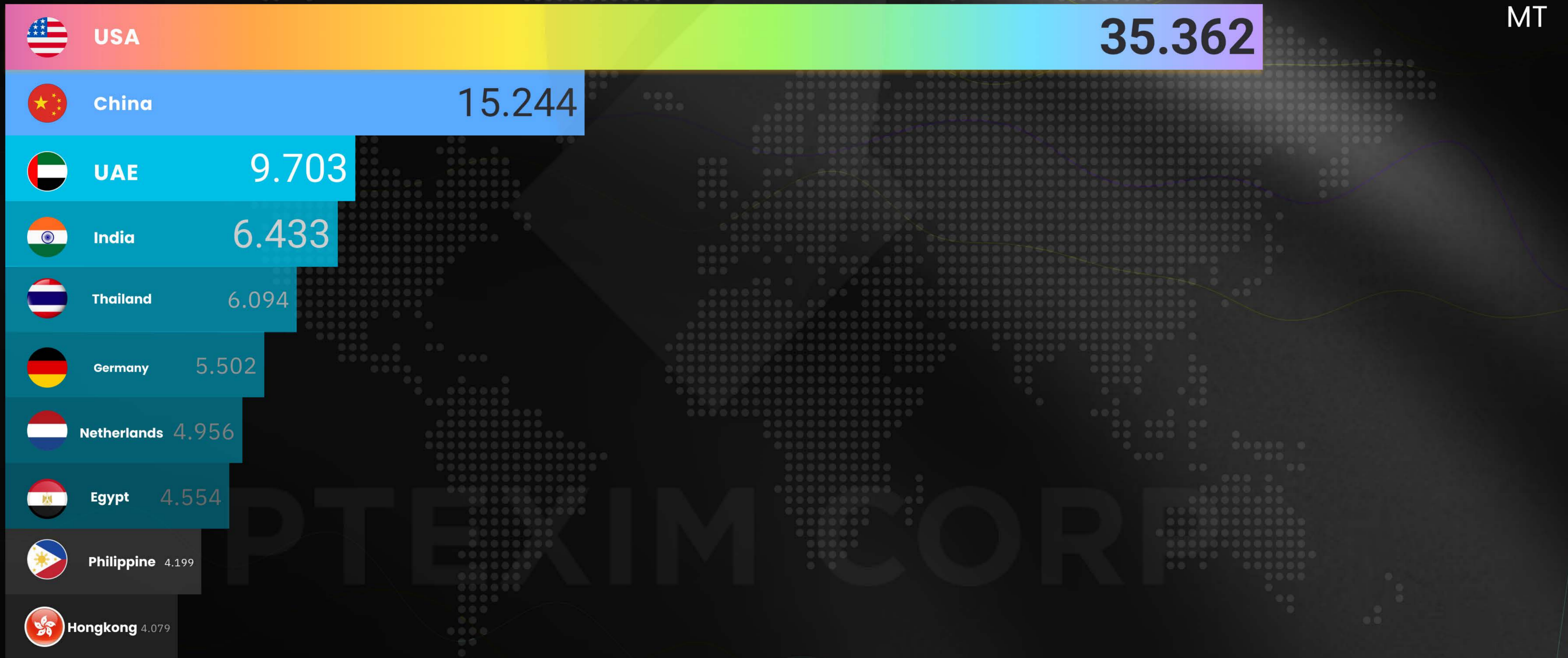

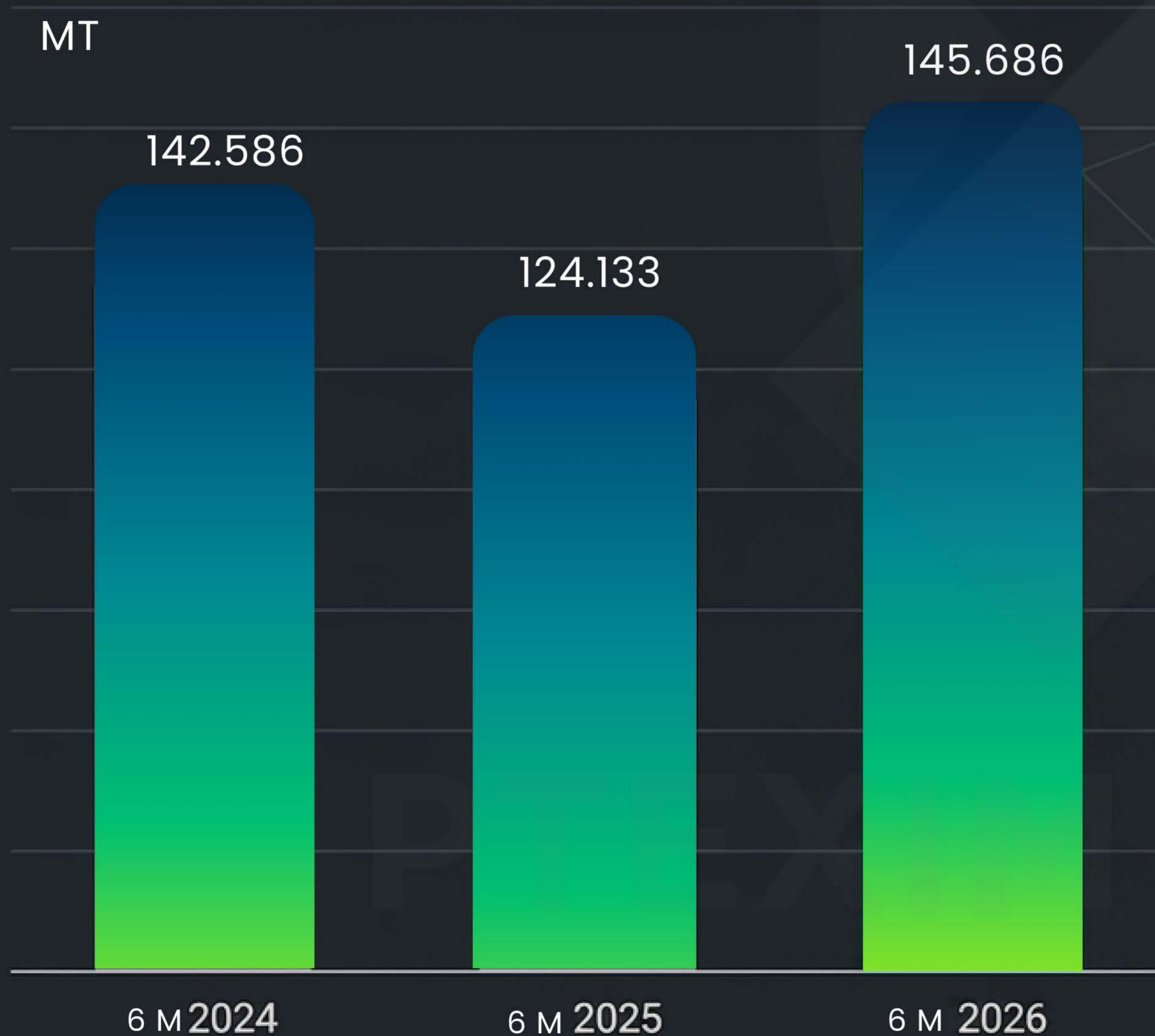

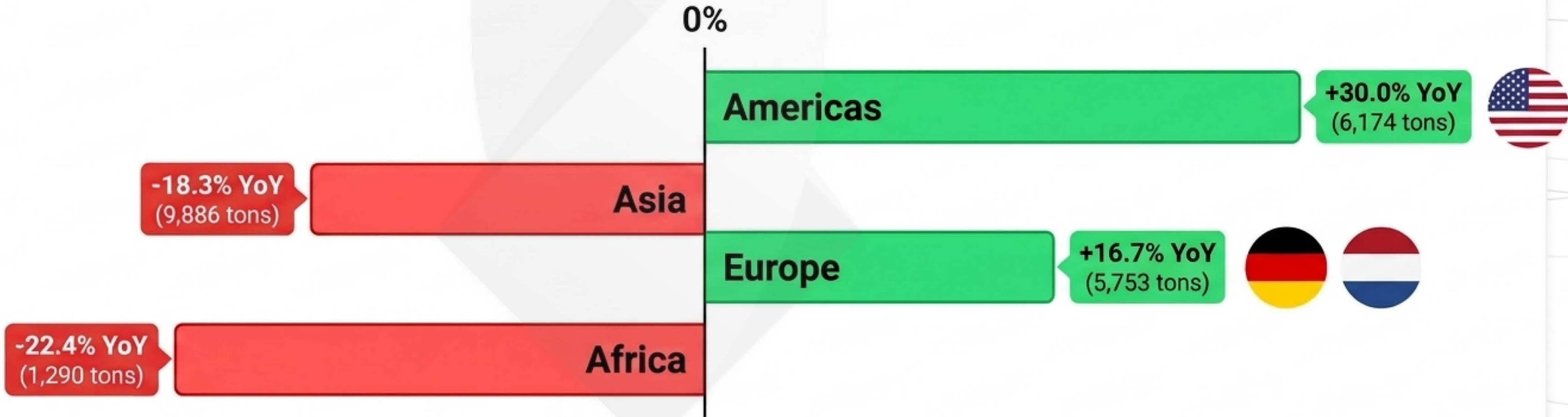


6 Months Period | 2024-2026 Black Pepper Exports Insight



Total pepper exports in the first six months of 2026 reached 145,686 tons, the highest level in the past three years. A notable point is that the export rate tended to slow down towards the end of the second quarter of 2026 (May and June saw decreases compared to previous months) due to increasingly limited domestic supply.

Significant Shift in Volume (YoY)

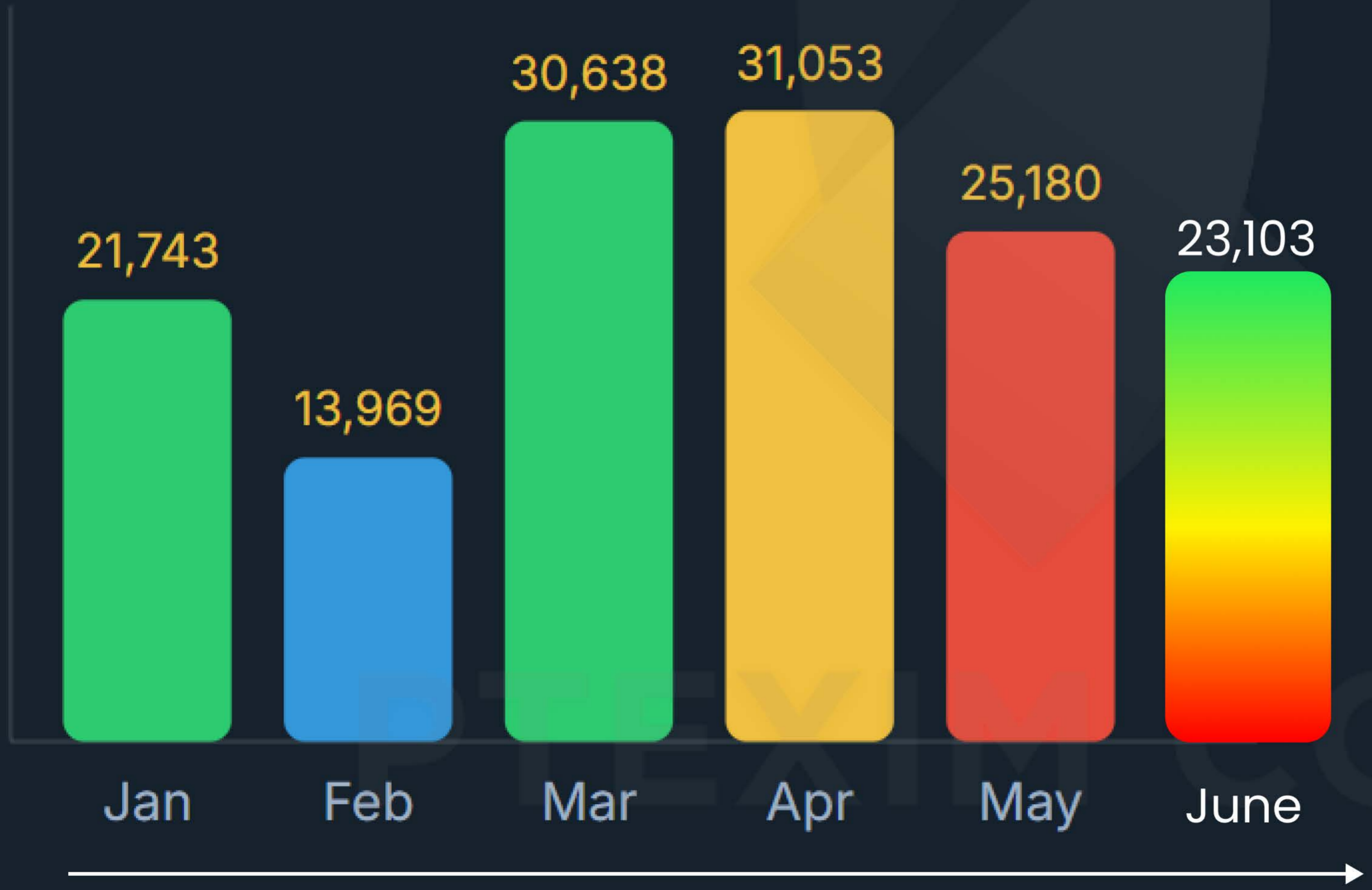
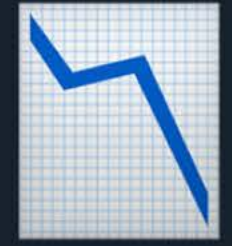


DEMAND SHIFT: Demand is shifting strongly to the Western Hemisphere. The Americas and Europe play the role of primary growth engines compared to the same period last year.

DETAILED INSIGHTS: The Americas alone account for 5,373 tons (up 21% YoY). Europe is driven by strong demand from Germany and the Netherlands.



The Challenge: Volatile Monthly Flows



June cooled -8.2% month-on-month a signal that Vietnam's tightening domestic supply is starting to cap momentum after a fast first half.

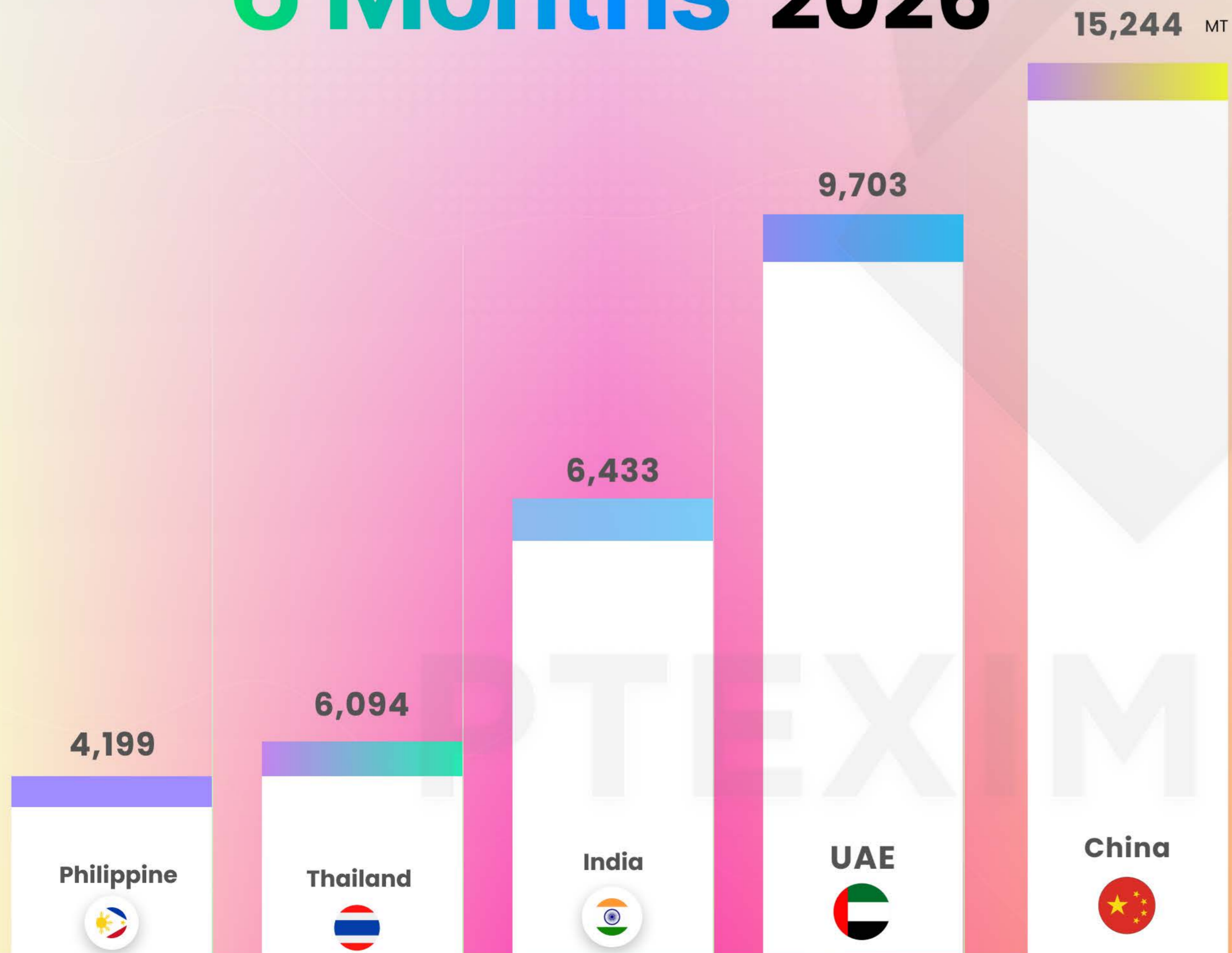

The Americas reached 39,339 tons, up 31.1%, accounting for 27.0%, with the United States continuing to be the single largest market with 35,362 tons, up 28.7% year-on-year.

ASIA



Asia continued to be the largest export region with 66,456 tons, accounting for 45.6% of total exports and increasing by 15.2% compared to the same period last year. In this region, China imported 15,244 tons, a sharp increase of 64.0%; the UAE reached 9,703 tons, up 10.9%, continuing to be an important transit hub for Vietnamese pepper; India reached 6,433 tons, down 27.2%, while Thailand nearly doubled its imports to 6,094 tons, up 95.9%.

ASIA Highlights: Momentum from UAE and India

Context: Though total exports to Asia fell 10.2% (especially China's 59.8% drop), two core markets maintained momentum.



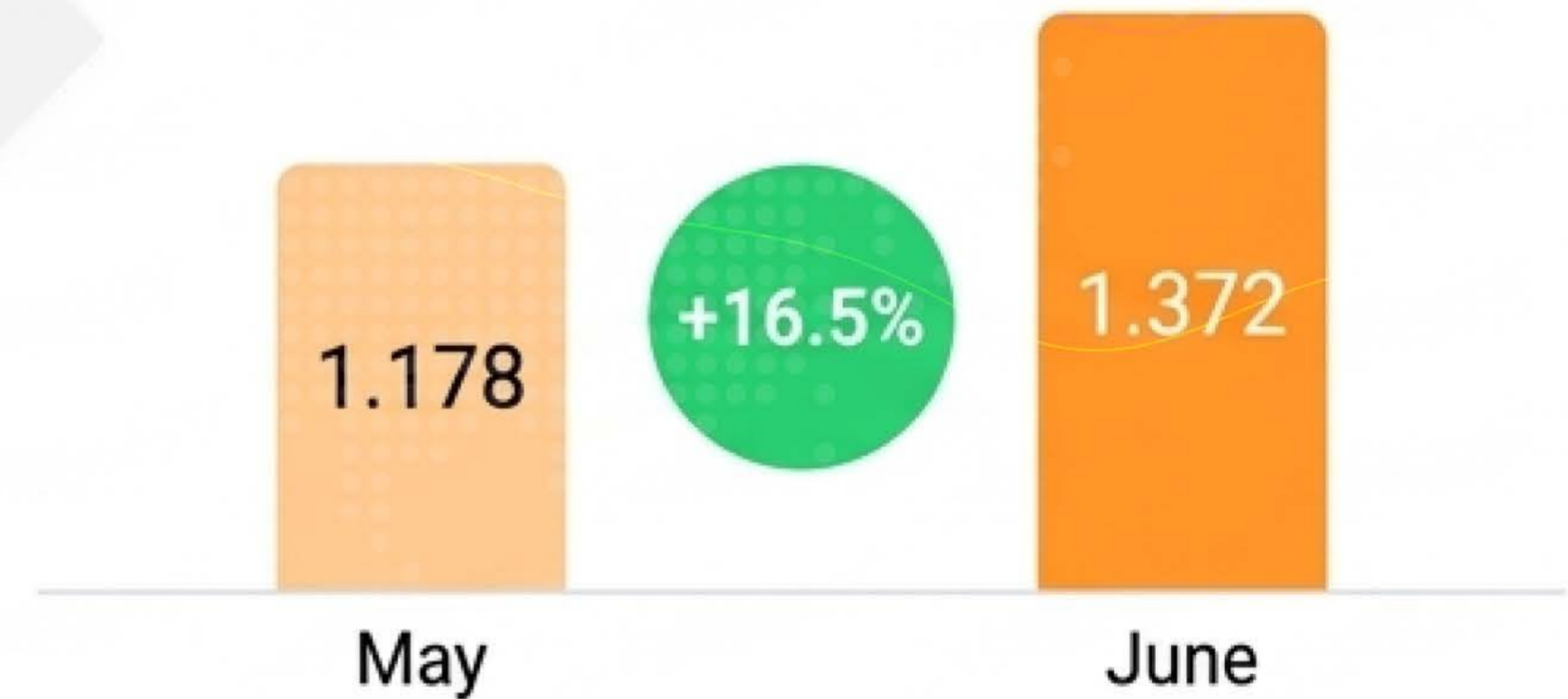

Continues to solidify its position as the most critical transit hub for Vietnamese pepper in the Middle East, achieving impressive 30.9% growth despite scarcity conditions.



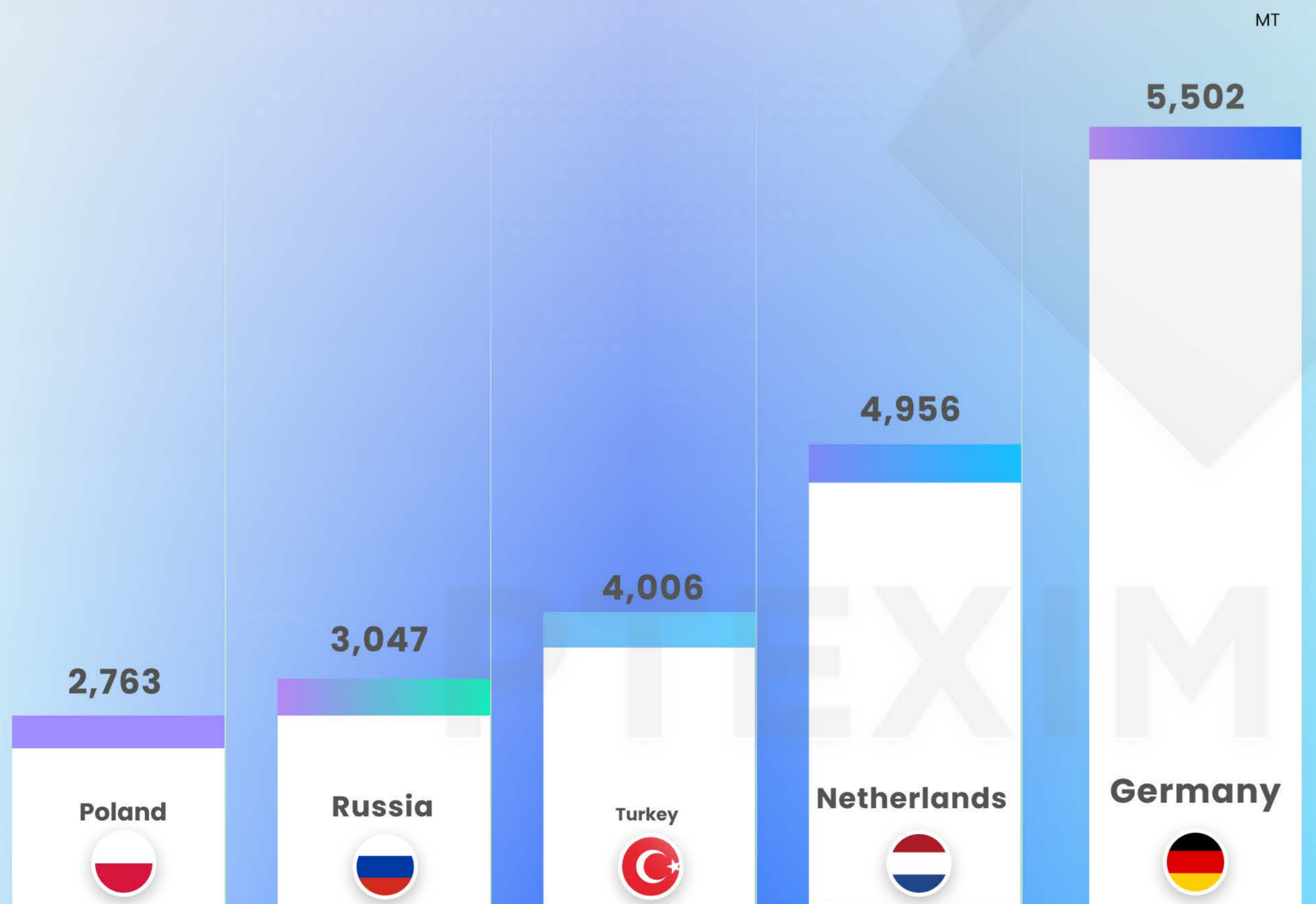
India (4.7% Market Share)

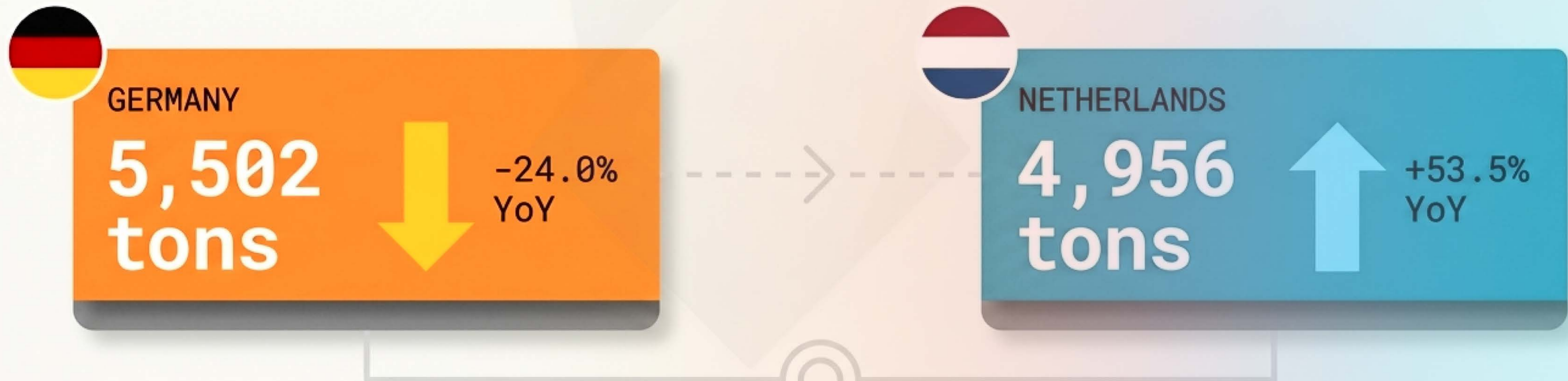


EUROPE



Europe reached 30,929 tons, up 7.1%, accounting for 21.2%, with the Netherlands increasing sharply by 53.5% to 4,956 tons, while Germany decreased by 24.0% to 5,502 tons.

European import volumes shift sharply from Germany to the Netherlands

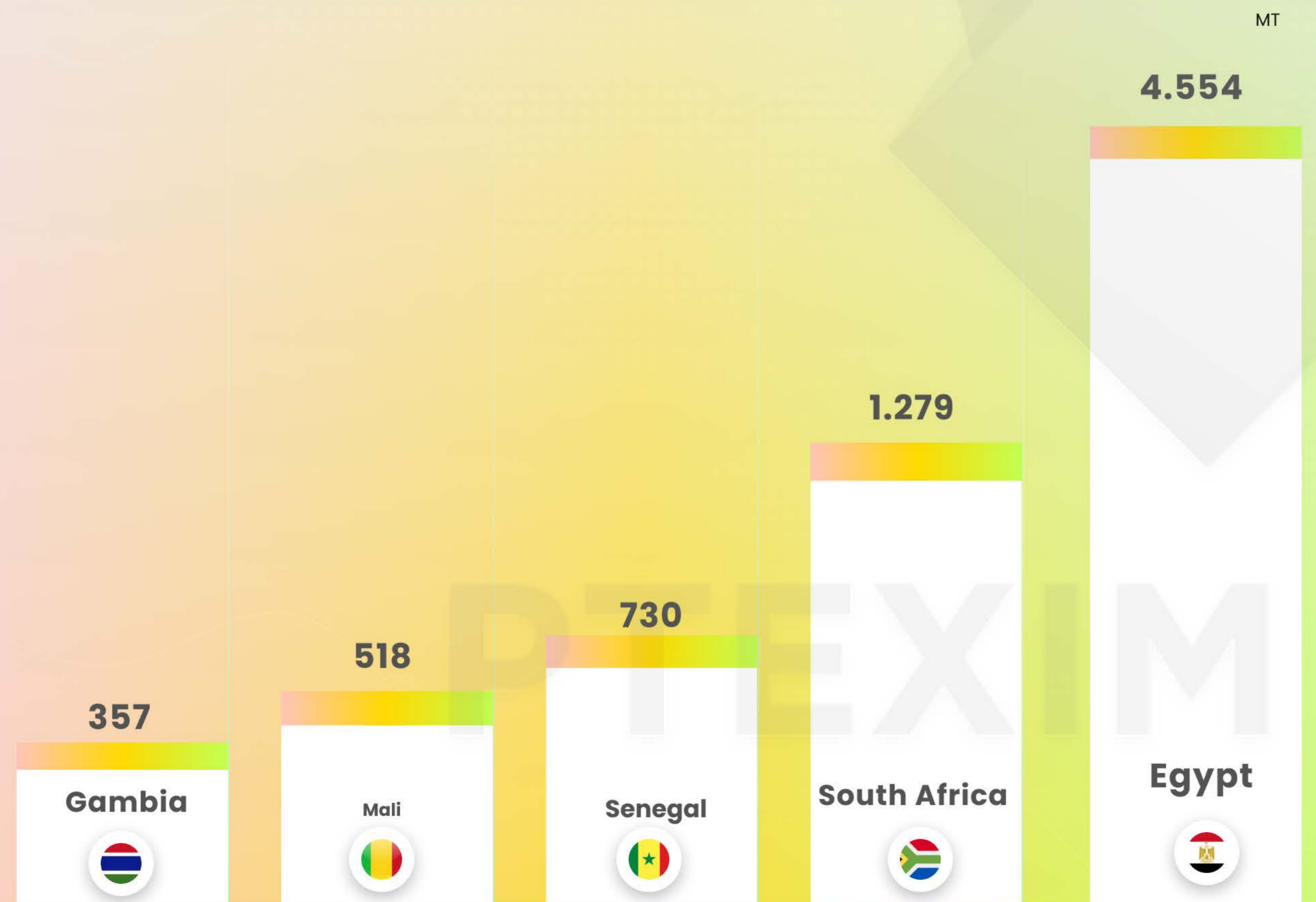


Overall European volume grew by a stable 7.1%, but the internal distribution reveals the Netherlands rapidly accelerating to match Germany's historic volume levels. June demand from these two nations kept Europe stable (-4.5% MOM) while other continents dropped.

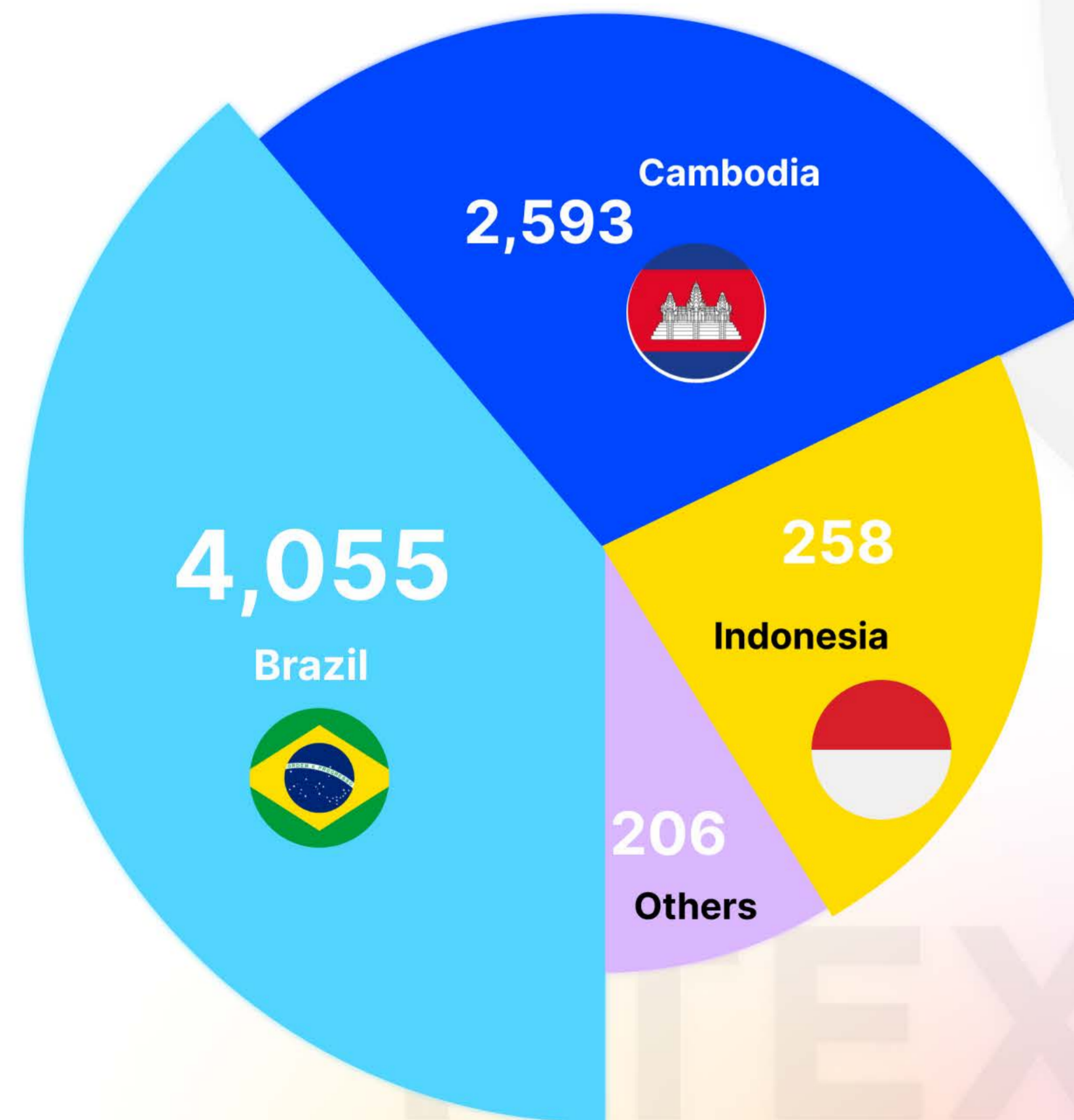

In June 2026, Vietnam imported 7,112 tons of pepper (7,023 tons black pepper, 89 tons white pepper), worth US\$39.9 million. Volume fell 18.7% and value fell 19.8% month-on-month, but volume was still up 23.4% year-on-year.

The month-on-month drop was mainly due to cooling imports from Cambodia after a sharp rise in May, while the year-on-year increase reflects businesses continuing to restock raw materials for processing and export.

By supplier market:

- Brazil: 4,055 tons (57.0% of total imports), up 15.6% MoM and up 18.0% YoY, remains the largest supplier.
- Cambodia: 2,593 tons (36.5%), down 42.2% MoM but still up 64.4% YoY.
- Indonesia: 258 tons, down 46.3% MoM and down 39.2% YoY.

In the first six months of 2026, Vietnam imported 45,198 tons of pepper (41,342 tons black pepper, 3,856 tons white pepper), worth US\$257.7 million | up 59.7% in volume and 48.0% in value year-on-year.

This sharp rise reflects growing reliance on imports as domestic pepper supply continues to shrink, making imported raw material increasingly critical for businesses to sustain production and meet export orders.

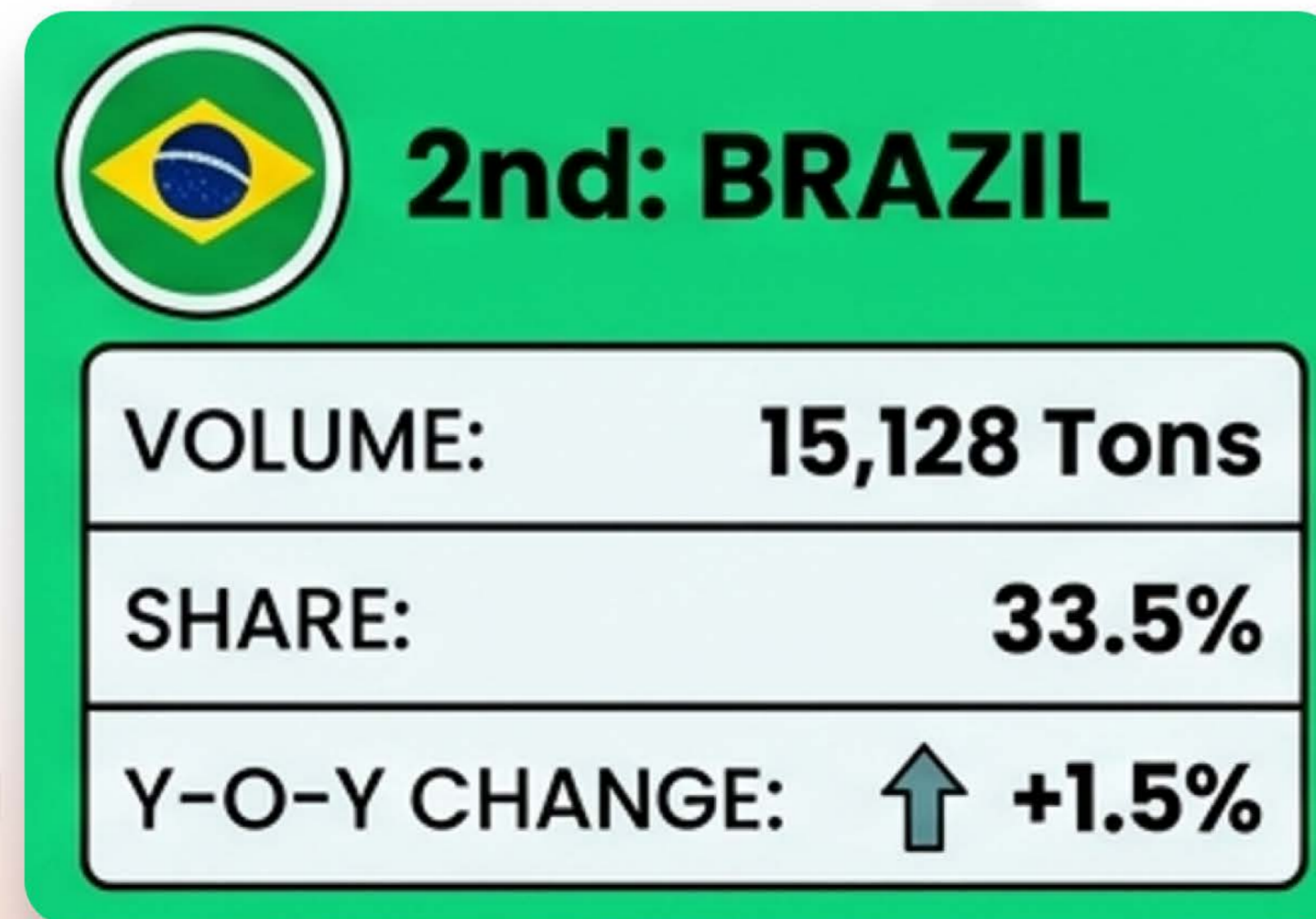
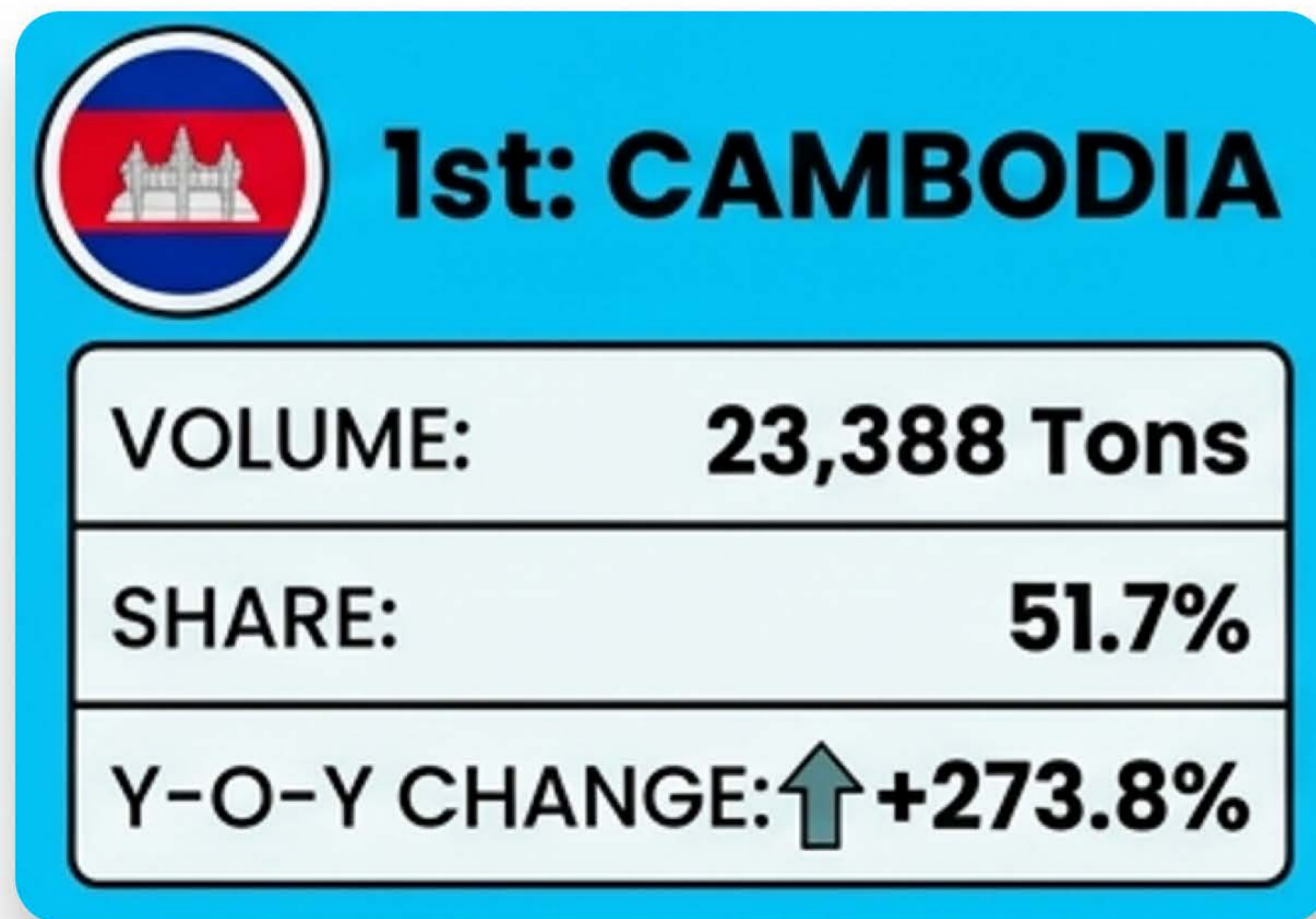

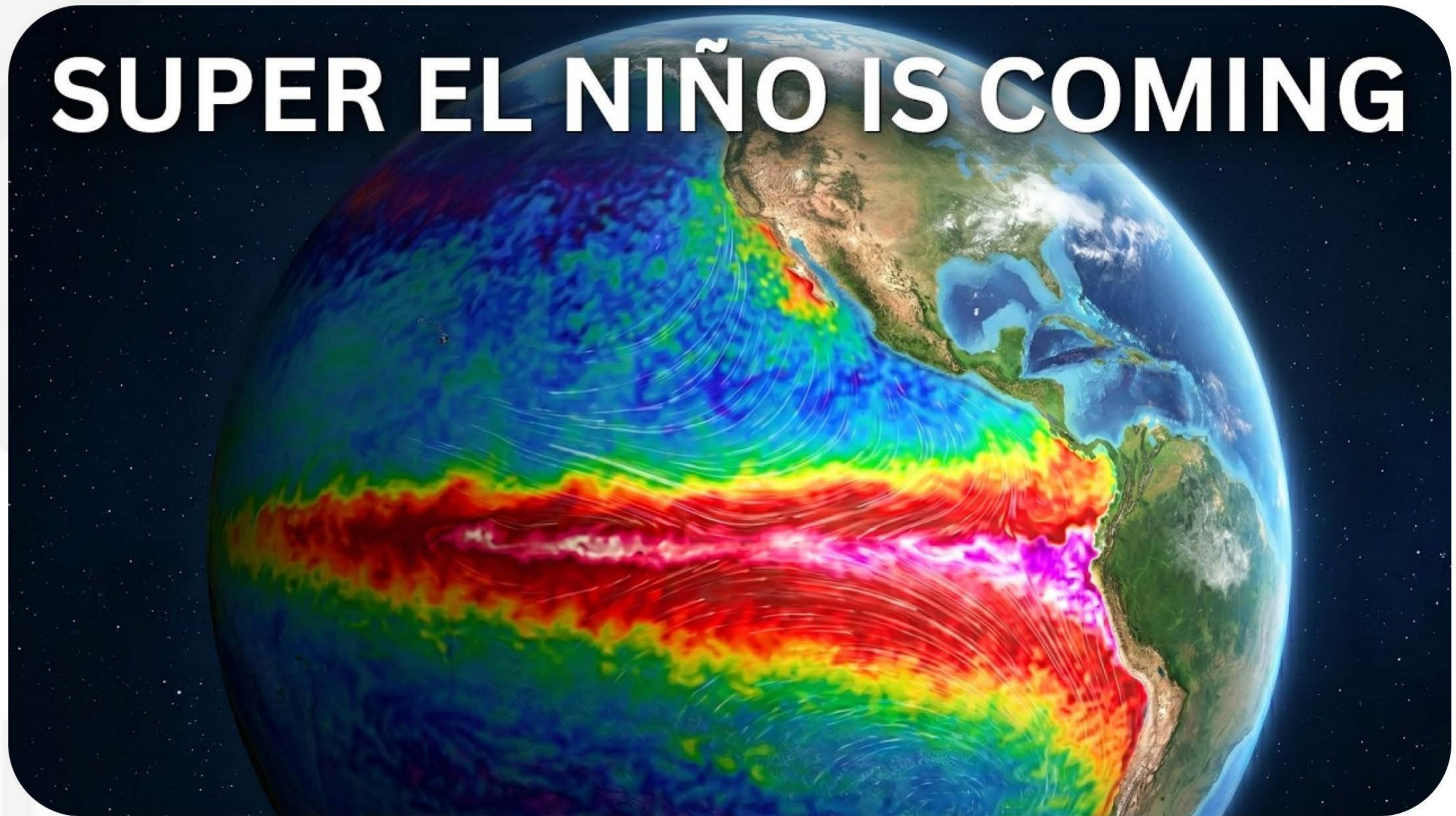

India Is Bringing Back Pepper Futures



1 El Niño Arrives Right As the Crop Base Is Already Thin

The single biggest medium-term risk to Vietnamese pepper supply isn't a one-month weather event it's that a weak El Niño is landing on top of a structurally undersized crop.



Vietnam's current supply shortfall traces back to the 2018 price crash, when many farmers uprooted pepper vines or stopped reinvesting. Since vines need 3–4 years to reach full productivity, those planting decisions are still suppressing 2025–2026 harvests – leaving the country with thin carry-over stocks and little buffer against a bad season.

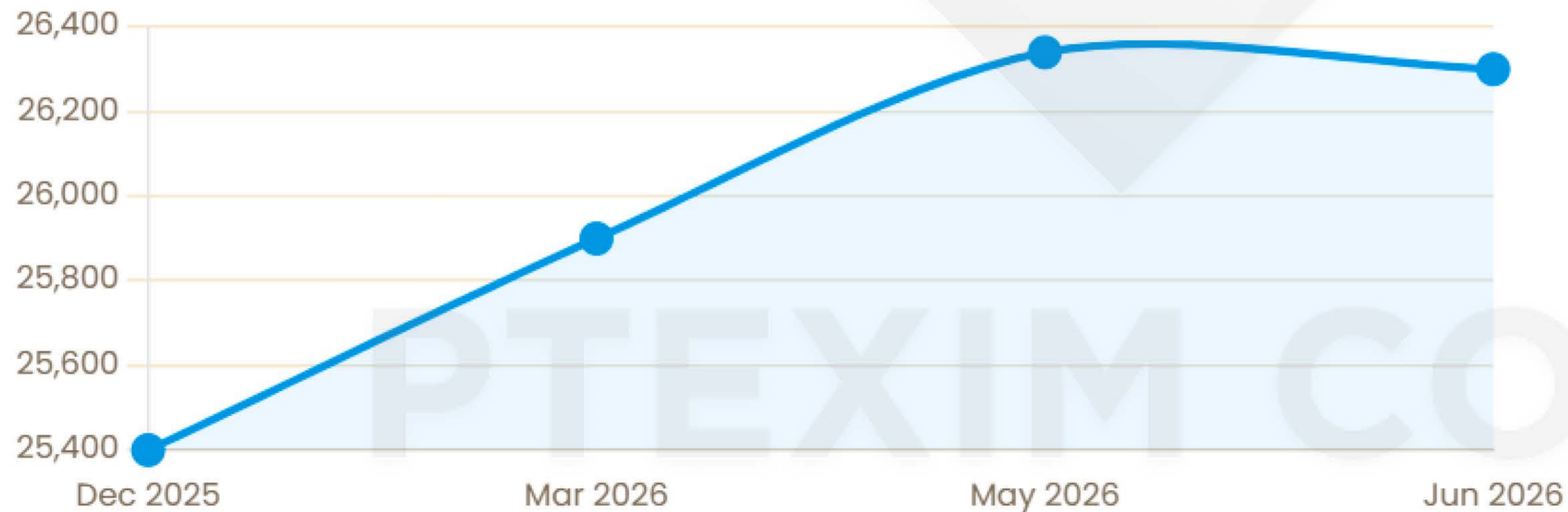

NOAA and Vietnam's National Centre for Hydro-Meteorological Forecasting now agree El Niño conditions are developing through June–August 2026, with some model runs assigning up to a 33% chance of a "super" El Niño rivalling 2015–16. Rainfall in the Central Highlands (Dak Lak, Dak Nong, Gia Lai, Lam Dong) has already run 20–25% below average earlier this year, with localized drought risk continuing into July.

3 A Softer Dong Is Quietly Supporting Export Competitiveness

USD/VND has moved from roughly 25,300–25,500 in December 2025 to around 26,290–26,340 as of early July 2026 – consistent with the State Bank of Vietnam's managed, gradual depreciation policy (targeted at 3–5% annually) rather than a disorderly move.



The Vietnamese dong has depreciated roughly 3.5% against the US dollar since late 2025 – a trend that eases the domestic-cost side of the ledger for exporters even as global buyers see stable dollar-denominated FOB prices.

India Is Bringing Back Pepper Futures

India's National Commodity and Derivatives Exchange (NCDEX) is preparing to relaunch pepper futures by the end of June 2026 – the first time since trading ceased in the early 2010s amid quality and delivery disputes. A new warehousing system is being built in Kerala as the primary delivery hub. If it gains liquidity, this could become a more transparent global price benchmark than the current patchwork of IPC-reported spot quotes, which is worth watching for anyone hedging forward purchases.

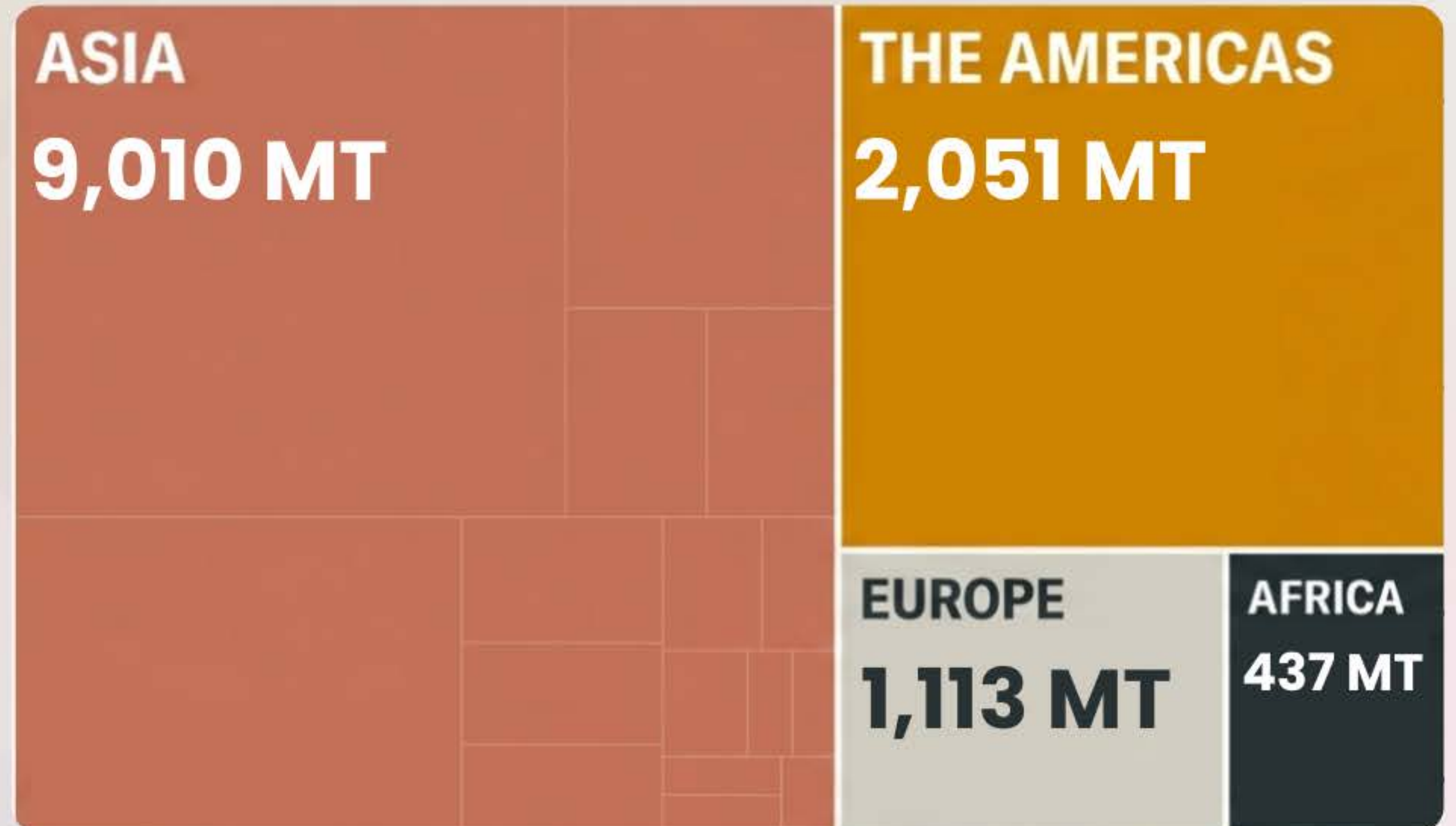

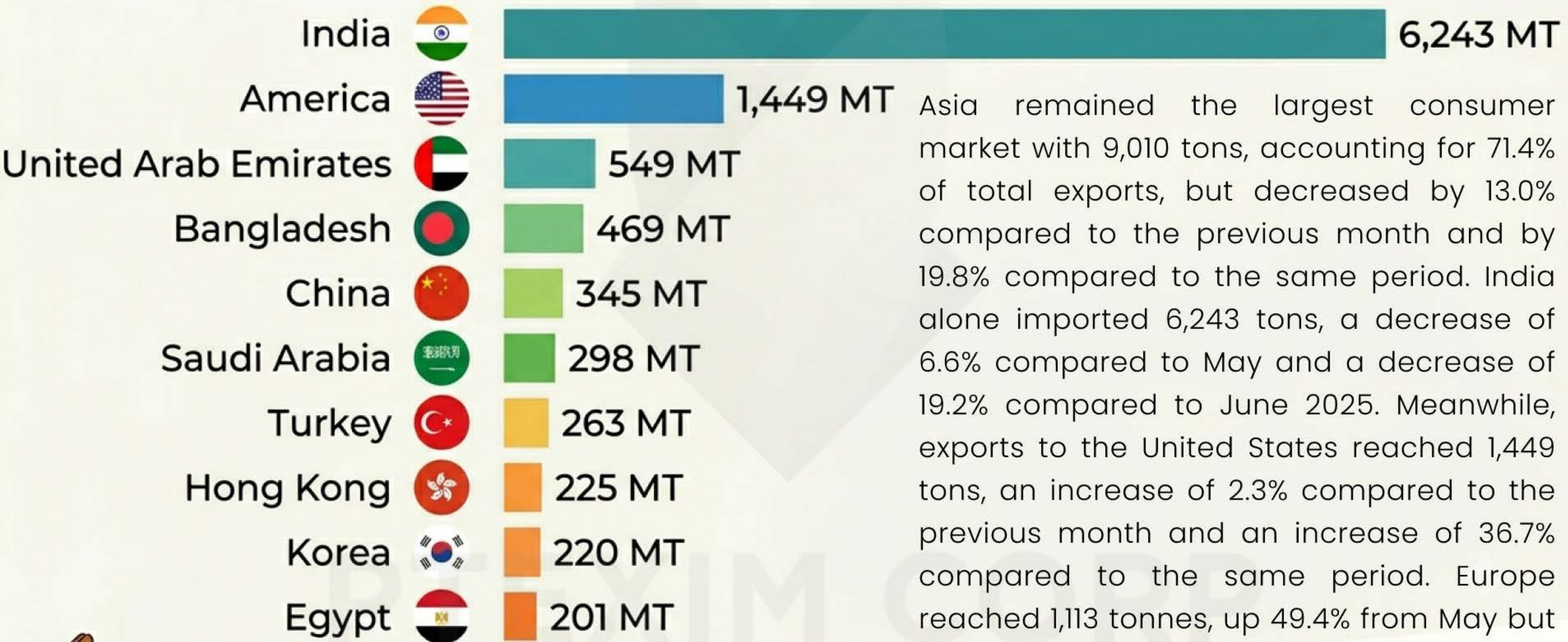

In June 2026, Vietnam exported 12,611 tons of Cassia, generating revenue of US\$31.9 million, a decrease of 9.5% in volume and 9.4% in value compared to May 2026, and a decrease of 11.3% in volume compared to the same period in June 2025.

Asia remained the largest consumer market with 9,010 tons, accounting for 71.4% of total exports, but decreased by 13.0% compared to the previous month and by 19.8% compared to the same period. India alone imported 6,243 tons, a decrease of 6.6% compared to May and a decrease of 19.2% compared to June 2025. Meanwhile, exports to the United States reached 1,449 tons, an increase of 2.3% compared to the previous month and an increase of 36.7% compared to the same period. Europe reached 1,113 tonnes, up 49.4% from May but still down 7.5% year-on-year.

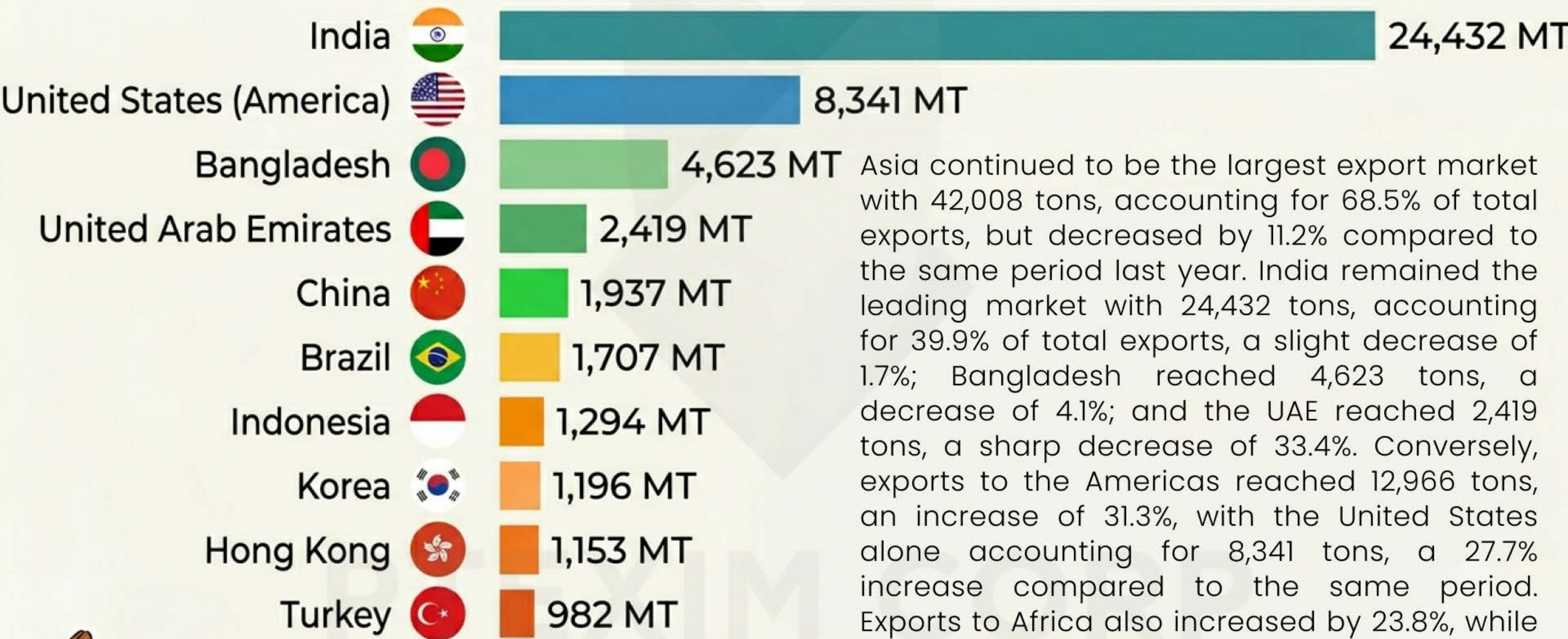

In the first six months of 2026, Vietnam exported 61,297 tons of cinnamon, generating \$156.2 million in revenue, a decrease of 3.4% in volume and 3.2% in value compared to the same period in 2025 (63,435 tons). Although exports started quite positively in the first quarter, the volume slowed down in May and June due to declining import demand in some Asian markets.



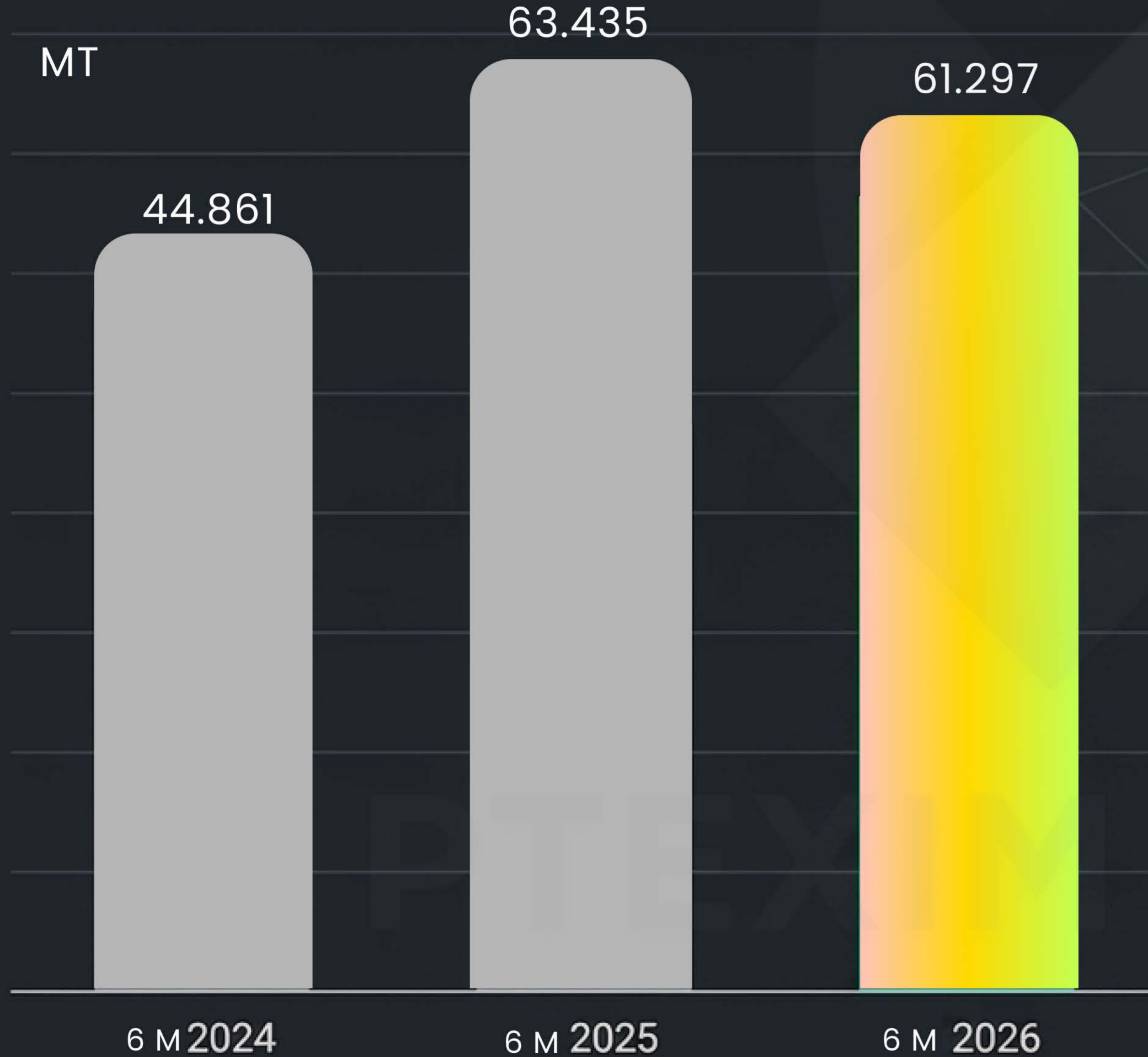

Asia continued to be the largest export market with 42,008 tons, accounting for 68.5% of total exports, but decreased by 11.2% compared to the same period last year. India remained the leading market with 24,432 tons, accounting for 39.9% of total exports, a slight decrease of 1.7%; Bangladesh reached 4,623 tons, a decrease of 4.1%; and the UAE reached 2,419 tons, a sharp decrease of 33.4%. Conversely, exports to the Americas reached 12,966 tons, an increase of 31.3%, with the United States alone accounting for 8,341 tons, a 27.7% increase compared to the same period. Exports to Africa also increased by 23.8%, while those to Europe decreased by 6.4%.



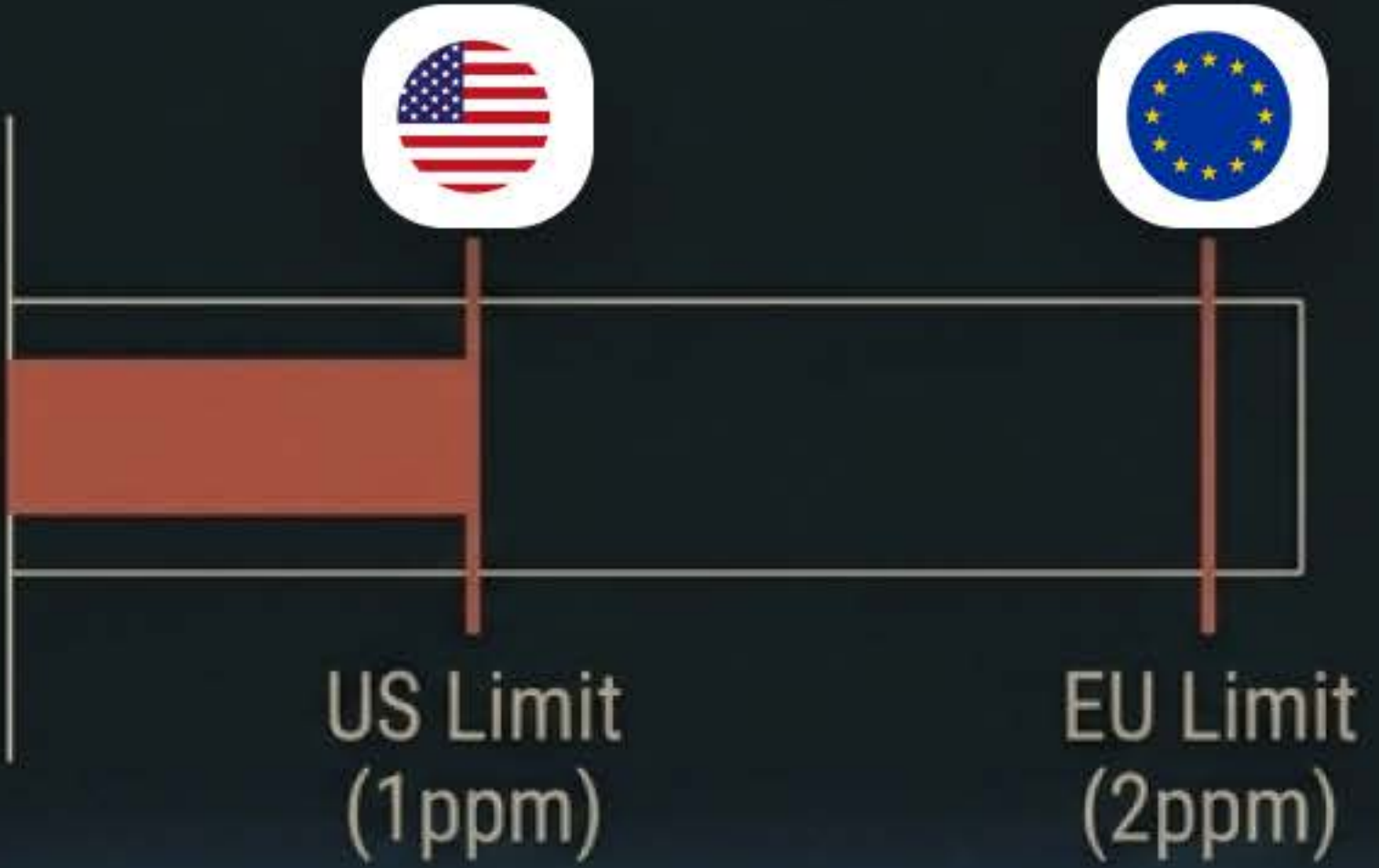

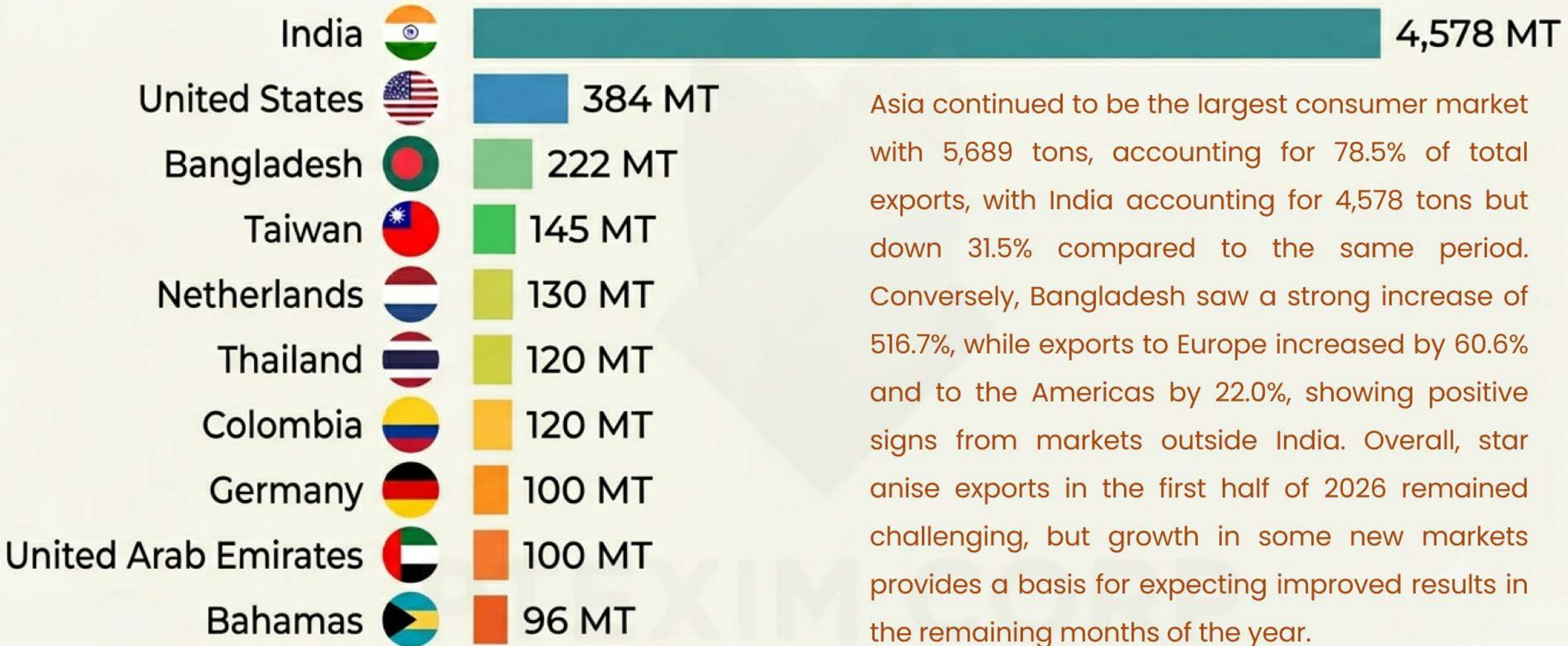
STAR ANISE Exports Insight | 6 months 2026 Insight



In the first six months of 2026, Vietnam exported 7,243 tons of star anise, generating \$28.7 million in revenue, a decrease of 16.5% in volume and 13.6% in value compared to the same period in 2025. Although exports in June increased slightly compared to the previous month, the cumulative results still declined due to weakening demand in traditional markets, especially India.



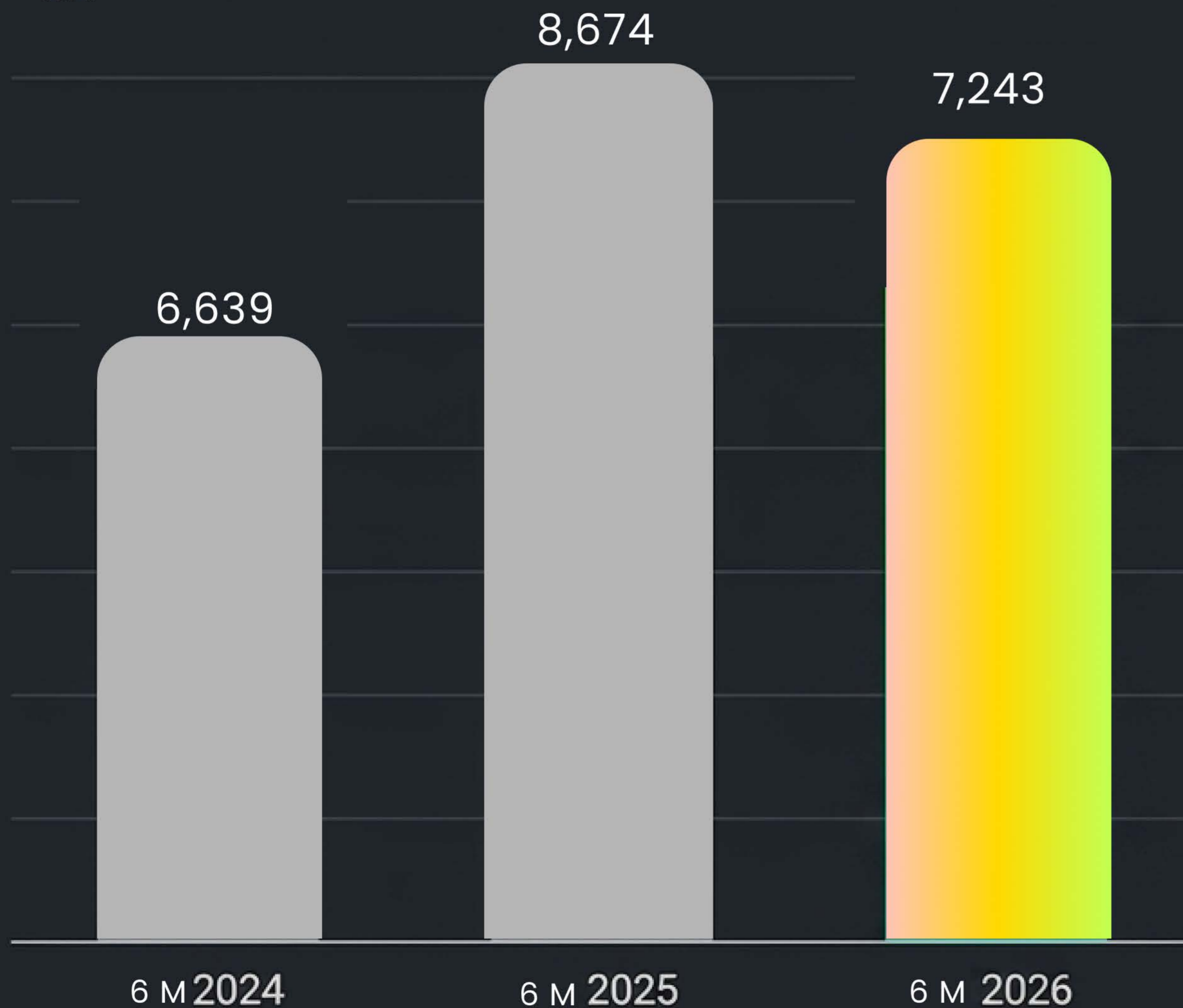
TOP 10 STAR ANISE EXPORT MARKETS FOR VIETNAM IN THE FIRST 6 MONTHS OF 2026 (MT)



Asia continued to be the largest consumer market with 5,689 tons, accounting for 78.5% of total exports, with India accounting for 4,578 tons but down 31.5% compared to the same period. Conversely, Bangladesh saw a strong increase of 516.7%, while exports to Europe increased by 60.6% and to the Americas by 22.0%, showing positive signs from markets outside India. Overall, star anise exports in the first half of 2026 remained challenging, but growth in some new markets provides a basis for expecting improved results in the remaining months of the year.
