








EXPORT OF VIETNAM BLACK PEPPER INSIGHT PERIOD 2016-2023































The total amount of pepper that can be exported from Vietnam for 2024 is about 235,000MTs – 275,000MTs. This is considered a very large number.

However, the harvest yield has continuously decreased over the past 3-4 years due to a reduction in cultivated areas as farmers are focusing on crops with higher profitability such as coffee and durian. It is predicted that the area for cultivating black pepper will likely continue to decrease in 2025.












































ANALYSIS OF FACTORS AFFECTING VIETNAM'S PEPPER CROP IN 2024



INVENTORY OF PEPPER IS FORECASTED TO DECREASE SIGNIFICANTLY

The inventory of pepper is forecasted to decrease significantly in the past 5 years due to the continuous decrease in pepper production in recent years. The main reason for the decrease in production is that farmers are switching to other crops that bring better profits such as coffee, durian. In addition, land prices in Vietnam have also increased rapidly, 5-10 times in just 3 years from 2020 to 2022, causing farmers to convert their pepper gardens to different types of real estate. This is also a major reason for the sharp decrease in pepper cultivation area in recent times.
















Pepper prices have been kept low for a long time, causing farmers to reduce investment in caring for existing pepper gardens, leading to a clear decrease in production.



Farmers Do Not Feel Pressured To Sell Black Pepper

The continuous rapid increase in raw coffee prices approaching black pepper prices has brought excitement to farmers who have achieved expected profits. Therefore, farmers do not feel pressured to sell black pepper after harvest as they have enough funds for fertilizers and labor. Farmers prioritize selling coffee and continue to buy and store black pepper when opportunities arise. Some speculators, including farmers and distributors, used capital to continuously purchase large quantities of black pepper in the past week and are prepared to store it for a long time, believing that black pepper prices will follow an upward trend in the next 2-3 years.

"Farmers' Association Unites For Pepper Market Surge: Collective **Action Boosts Sentiment And Prices**"

At present, the farmers' association, comprising a robust community of 200,000 members, receives rapid updates on both global and local market conditions. Each day, individuals actively engage with the group, encouraging one another to retain their pepper supply rather than selling or stockpiling it. This collective sentiment is expected to result in a significant 20-50% increase in prices in the near future. The influence and impact of these exhortations on farmers are of great significance, emphasizing the importance of solidarity and collective action.


















Forecast Of The World Pepper Crop ln 2024



The low pepper prices maintained for many years have caused farmers to lose patience in caring for and developing pepper gardens. Farmers have converted their planting areas to short-day crops and other crops with better economic value, such as palm trees. It is expected that pepper production from Indonesia will decrease in the next 1-2 years, with a reduction of 10-20% per year.










YEARLY WORLD CONSUMPTION
