October 2025 Black Pepper **Exports Insight**

According to VPSA statistics, in October 2025, Vietnam exported 19,430 tons of pepper, black pepper reached 16,464 tons, white pepper reached 2,966 tons. Total export turnover reached 129.5 million USD, compared to the previous month, export volume decreased by 5.2%, turnover decreased by 5.0% and compared to the same period in 2024, export volume increased by 5.1%, turnover increased by 7.7%. The average export price of black pepper in October reached 6,443 USD/ton, white pepper reached 8,392 USD/ton, down 47 USD for black pepper and 185 USD for white pepper compared to September.








TOP EXPORT MARKETS October 2025

Meanwhile, the United States continued to be the leading pepper export market of Vietnamese pepper, reaching 4,274 tons, down 11.1% compared to August. Followed by the markets: China: 2,071 tons, UAE: 1,962 tons, Netherlands: 940 tons, Thailand: 863 tons and Germany: 861 tons.




























10 Months 2025

By the end of October 2025, Vietnam had exported 206,427 tons of pepper, of which black pepper reached 176,577 tons and white pepper reached 29,850 tons. Total export turnover reached 1 billion 393.7 million USD, black pepper reached 1 billion 145.6 million USD, white pepper reached 244.0 million USD. Compared to the same period last year, the export volume decreased by 5.9% but the export turnover increased by 25.4%. The average export price of black pepper in 10 months reached 6,628 USD/ton, white pepper reached 8,683 USD/ton, up 36.6% for black pepper and 34.4% for white pepper compared to the same period in 2024.

TOP EXPORT MARKETS 10 Months 2025

The main export markets of Vietnamese Pepper include: The United States reached 44,262 tons, accounting for 21.4% and decreased by 29.4% compared to the same period in 2024 but increased by 3.9% compared to the same period in 2023. Followed by the markets: UAE reached 17,304 tons, accounting for 8.4%, up 18.8%; China reached 16,567 tons, accounting for 8.0%, up 79.1%; India reached 11,370 tons, accounting for 5.5%, up 20.6% and Germany reached 10,198 tons, accounting for 4.9% and down 25.8% over the same period in 2024. Some major markets also had increased export volumes such as Thailand (29.1%), Poland (23.7%), Turkey (10.3%), Egypt (4.2%), South Korea (2.0%)...










PEPPER IMPORTING IN OCTOBER 2025

Black pepper Import 1,671



Preliminary statistics of VPSA, in September 2025, Vietnam imported 1,671 tons of pepper, with a turnover of 11.2 million USD, black pepper reached 1,498 tons, white pepper reached 173 tons. Compared to the previous month, the import volume increased by 5.2% and compared to October 2024, the import decreased by 65.3%. Vietnam imported pepper mainly from Brazil, accounting for 38.7%, reaching 646 tons, followed by Cambodia, accounting for 26.0%, reaching 435 tons, and Indonesia, accounting for 19.3%, reaching 322 tons.


































PEPPER IMPORTING IN 10 MONTHS 2025



Black pepper Import 37,783_{MT}

Cumulatively from January 1 to October 31, 2025, Vietnam imported 37,783 tons of pepper, with a total import turnover of 236.9 million USD, black pepper reaching 32,226 tons, white pepper reaching 5,557 tons. Compared to the same period last year, the import volume increased by 32.1%; turnover increased by 804% and compared to the same period in 2023, the import volume increased by 67.9%. Brazil is the largest pepper supplier to Vietnam, reaching 18,481 tons, up 105.0% over the same period, accounting for 48.9%. Followed by Cambodia reaching 9,705 tons, up 45%, accounting for 25.7% of the market share; Indonesia reached 6,946 tons, down 32.5% and accounting for 18.4% of the import market share.
























Fourth Consecutive Weekly Increase After A 17-Week Decline

The Drewry World Container Index (WCI) rose 8% to \$1,959 per 40ft container

WCI Trade Routes from Shanghai (US\$/40ft)



The Drewry World Container Index (WCI) rose 8% to \$1,959 per 40ft container, marking the fourth consecutive weekly increase after a 17week decline.

- Shanghai Los Angeles: up 9% to \$2,647 per 40ft container.
- Shanghai New York: up 8% to \$3,837 per 40ft container.
 - → The rise was driven by General Rate Increases (GRIs) implemented on November 1 to offset downward pressure from excess capacity. However, this upward trend is expected to be temporary unless additional GRIs are introduced.
- Shanghai Rotterdam: up 9% to \$1,962 per 40ft container.
- Genoa: up 8% to \$2,111 per 40ft container. Shanghai
 - → Carriers on the Asia-Europe route are raising FAK rates to \$3,000-\$3,600 per 40ft container (effective November 15) in an attempt to lift spot rates ahead of the new annual contract season.

Drewry's forecast indicates that the supply-demand balance will weaken in the coming quarters, likely causing spot rates to decline again.


USD/VND exchange rate showed a slight upward trend this week, reflecting continued market adjustment after the U.S. Federal Reserve's rate cut.

The European Union has issued multiple import alerts for spices, herbs, and seeds from various countries over recent weeks, citing regulatory violations. This reflects:


- Increased quality control and safety inspections
- Stricter enforcement of EU food safety standards
- Multiple countries of origin affected
- Enhanced documentation requirements





Action Items for Importers:

- Verify supplier compliance with EU regulations (pesticide residues, aflatoxins, microbiological standards)
- Request updated certificates of analysis and phytosanitary certificates
- Ensure traceability documentation is complete and accurate
- Consider pre-shipment testing to avoid customs delays
- Stay informed on specific alert updates for Vietnamese products

Cassia Exports Insight October 2025

According to VPSA's preliminary statistics, in October 2025, Vietnam exported 8,985 tons of cinnamon, with a total export turnover of 21.2 million USD, compared to the previous month, exports increased by 20.9% in volume and 18.5% in value, and compared to the same period in 2023, the export volume decreased by 11.6%. India, Bangladesh and the United States are the 3 main export markets of Vietnamese Cinnamon, reaching: 2,458 tons, up 8.2%, 1,385 tons, up 160.8% and 1,006 tons, down 16.2% compared to the previous month.

By the end of October 2025, Vietnam had exported 99,463 tons of cinnamon, with a total export turnover of 249.5 million USD. Compared to the same period in 2024, the export volume increased by 25.1% and the turnover increased by 13.2%. The leading export markets of Vietnamese cinnamon include: India: 37,787 tons, up 37.9% over the same period and accounting for 38.0% of the export market share. Followed by the United States: 10,957 tons, up 27.2%, accounting for 11.0% of the market share; Bangladesh: 8,000 tons, up 16.8%, accounting for 8.0% of the market share; UAE: 5,265 tons, up 121.4%, accounting for 5.3% and China: 4,498 tons, up 162.0% and accounting for 4.5% of the export market share.























In October, Vietnam's Star Anise exports reached 705 tons, with a turnover of 3.4 million USD, compared to the previous month, the export volume decreased by 25.4% and the turnover decreased by 21.8%. India was the largest Star Anise export market in October, reaching 321 tons, while Senspices Vietnam was the largest Star Anise exporter, reaching 80 tons. By the end of October 2025, Vietnam had exported 11,898 tons of Star Anise, with a total export turnover of 47.9 million USD. Compared to the same period last year, the export volume increased by 6.7% but the turnover decreased by 9.0%. India and the United States are the two largest export markets, reaching 8,621 tons, accounting for 72.5% and 825 tons, accounting for 6.9% of the export market share.




















